

EBAN Awards – Selection process

How are Jury members appointed?

By the EBAN Secretariat and the host organization every year, in this case in collaboration with ESBAN.

Who are the Jury's this year? Is there a good geographical and experience mix?

We always make sure that there is a good geographical and experience spread.

We always seek to avoid conflicts of interest (no jury member can present a submission with its organization) .

Jury members are being appointed and will be revealed very soon.

Is there a Jury member for each award?

There will be 5 Jury members to ensure we always have a majority vote.

How do the Jury screen the candidates and vote?

EBAN will only retain the 4 best submissions per category. If EBAN receives more, jury members will be asked to make a first selection via a conference call (they receive submissions via email).

Organisations/individuals that are not shortlisted will be informed, with some information about why their submission was not selected provided by jury members.

A final conference call date is set where all jury members are asked to rank the submissions (1 to 4) and provide the Secretariat (who coordinates the call and takes minutes but does not provide any additional information than submitted) with the main reasons for choosing the winner.

Winners are kept confidential until the date of the event.
